

Before You Go



How does a surprise road trip work?



Pick a Date

We recommend doing the trip within **6 months** of receiving this road trip. Pay close attention to the 'When To Go' within the 'Navigating the Road' section of this booklet.



Get Ready

The only requirement is having a vehicle, GPS and a driver. The trip is completely **self-guided**, so nothing needs to be booked in advance.



Check Updates

Before leaving, please check **travel updates** on our website. This will provide you with any major changes to the itinerary.



Pack Your Bag

Please refer to the 'What to Pack' list in this booklet for items we recommend bringing with you.



Hit the Road!

Don't open the first envelope until you're ready to leave. Once you're finished at the first stop, you can open the second envelope. Four stops are included within your road trip.

Your day ahead! Without giving away too many details.

We often include a variety of recommendations at each stop. You do not have to go to all of them; pick and choose what works best for you and your travel mates. If you can't get through all of the stops during the day - come back and explore them at a later date!





Time to Depart!

We recommend departing between 9:00 and 9:30 am. The later you leave, the less time you'll have to explore all of the stops.

Markets & Mazes

Recommended duration: 30 minutes Drive time to second stop: 15 minutes

*One food option it recommended at this stop

For The Bird Lover

Recommended duration: 1 hour Drive time to third stop: 20 minutes

A Secret Animal Encounter

Recommended duration: 1 - 1.5 hours Drive time to fourth stop: 15 minutes

*Multiple food options are available at this stop

We're Goat-ing on an Adventure!

Recommended duration: 1 hour *Requires advance reservations*

*One food option is recommended at this stop



Navigating the Road



When to Go

- Best done from Wednesday -**Sunday** in the fall/winter, but can be done any day of the week in the spring/summer months.
- One option in stop #1 has seasonal activities (summer/fall), but the featured stop is open year-round.

TRAVEL TIP: We recommend quite a few rural stops on this trip that have limited washroom access. Be sure to take advantage of the washrooms available at the first and third stops. There are portable washrooms available at the fourth stop.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much will the stops cost?

First Stop: Our alternative stop has a few paid options, but is free to enter. Our featured stop is free.

Second Stop: Pay-and-display parking is in effect at this stop.

Third Stop: Pay-and-display parking is in effect at this stop.

Fourth Stop: This stop needs to be booked and paid (\$) in advance. Upon arrival they require a small cash conation per person to help support the animals.

*Please note: gas, tolls, and food may be additional costs.

Can I feed the animals?

Some stops do encourage you to feed the animals, while others do not. Please always respect the rules and posted signs.

When should we leave?

We recommend leaving anytime between **9:00 and 9:30 am**. The later you leave, the less time you may have to complete all of the stops.

Can I bring my dog?

This trip is unfortunately **not fit for your pup.** There are many farm stops with working dogs and other animals who will get startled by being around outside pets.

How do I reserve the 4th stop?

Your fourth stop must be booked in advance. Please follow the QR Code below to book a time. We recommend booking your time **between 2 and 3pm**. Feeling rushed? Don't worry, they're very flexible with your arrival time!



How long will the total trip take?

See the approximate round-trip driving distances/times below. These are driving distances only and do not factor in time spent at stops.

From **Downtown Toronto**:

2 hours and 26 minutes / 188 km

From **Brampton**:

2 hours and 11 minutes / 189 km

From **Pickering**:

3 hours / 266 km

From **Kitchener/Waterloo**:

2 hours and 17 minutes / 153 km

From Newmarket:

2 hours and 13 minutes / 288 km

From London:

3 hours and 18 minutes / 285 km

From Niagara Falls:

2 hours and 29 minutes / 216 km

*We recommend booking an overnight hotel if the driving distance is greater than 4 hours round-trip.

How many people can I bring with me?

We recommended bringing up to 5 people on your surprise road trip.

If you're bringing a larger group, we highly recommend having one person in charge of booking reservations at restaurants and attractions in advance. Please see the previous page for a copy of the digital itinerary.

Is this wheelchair or stroller accessible?

First Stop: One option is fully accessible. Another option is only somewhat accessible.

Second Stop: This stop is somewhat accessible.

Third Stop: This stop is accessible.

Fourth Stop: Our featured stop is somewhat accessible. We have an alternative suggestion that is fully accessible.




Risk
