

Before You Go



How does a surprise road trip work?



Pick a Date

We recommend doing the trip within **6 months** of receiving this road trip. Pay close attention to the 'When To Go' within the 'Navigating the Road' section of this booklet.



Get Ready

The only requirement is having a vehicle, GPS and a driver. The trip is completely **self-guided**, so nothing needs to be booked in advance.



Check Updates

Before leaving, please check **travel updates** on our website. This will provide you with any major changes to the itinerary.



Pack Your Bag

Please refer to the 'What to Pack' list in this booklet for items we recommend bringing with you.



Hit the Road!

Don't open the first envelope until you're ready to leave. Once you're finished at the first stop, you can open the second envelope. Four stops are included within your road trip.

Your day ahead! Without giving away too many details.

We often include a variety of recommendations at each stop. You do not have to go to all of them, pick and choose what works best for you and your travel mates. If you can't get through all of the stops during the day - come back and explore them at a later date!





Time to Depart!

We recommend departing no later than **8:00 am if you're coming from the GTA.** (This trip is fairly long, but so worth it!)

When to Go

- This trip is best done **between** Wednesday - Sunday any time of the year.
- We do not recommend travelling on a Monday or Tuesday.



Stay Overnight

We <u>highly recommend</u> making this an overnight trip, especially if you're departing from Toronto, the GTA or Kitchener/Waterloo. See the link below for a list of recommended accommodations close to the last stop.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much will the stops cost?

First Stop: No fee

Second Stop: One beach option has a parking fee (\$) from May - Oct. We've provided other free options.

Third Stop: No fee

Fourth Stop: Two stops require small entrance fees (\$). We've provided several free options.

*Please note: gas, tolls, and food may be additional costs.

When should we leave?

We recommend leaving around 8:00 am if you're coming from the GTA, and closer to 9:00 am if you're coming from Barrie. The later you leave, the less time you may have to complete all of the stops.

Can I bring my dog?

This trip is pet friendly! At every stop there will be at least one pet-friendly option. Please keep your dog on a leash at all times, and note that our shop and eatery suggestions most often only allow pets on outdoor patios.

How long will the total trip take?

See the approximate round-trip driving distances/times below. These are driving distances only and do not factor in time spent at stops.

From **Downtown Toronto***:

5 hours and 28 minutes / 419 km

From Kitchener/Waterloo*:

4 hours and 45 minutes / 349 km

From Guelph*:

4 hours and 30 minutes / 326 km

From Barrie:

3 hours and 46 minutes / 251 km

From Kincardine:

3 hours and 35 minutes / 268 km

From **Collingwood**:

2 hours and 15 minutes / 150 km

*We highly recommend booking an overnight hotel if the driving distance is greater than 4 hours round-trip.

How many people can I bring with me?

We recommended bringing up to 5 people on your surprise road trip.

If you're bringing a larger group, we highly recommend having one person in charge of booking reservations at restaurants and attractions in advance. Please see the previous page for a copy of the digital itinerary.

Is this wheelchair or stroller accessible?

First Stop: This stop is accessible.

Second Stop: This stop is somewhat accessible.

Third Stop: One trail option on this stop is not accessible. We've provided a lookout and winery option that are both accessible.


Fourth Stop: Our waterfall options on this stop are not accessible. We've provided several in-town museum and eatery options that are accessible.
