

Before You Go



How does a surprise road trip work?



Pick a Date

We recommend doing the trip within **6 months** of receiving this road trip. Pay close attention to the 'When To Go' within the 'Navigating the Road' section of this booklet.



Get Ready

The only requirement is having a vehicle, GPS and a driver. The trip is completely **self-guided**, so nothing needs to be booked in advance.



Check Updates

Before leaving, please check **travel updates** on our website. This will provide you with any major changes to the itinerary.



Pack Your Bag

Please refer to the 'What to Pack' list in this booklet for items we recommend bringing with you.



Hit the Road!

Don't open the first envelope until you're ready to leave. Once you're finished at the first stop, you can open the second envelope. Four stops are included within your road trip.

Your day ahead! Without giving away too many details.

We often include a variety of recommendations at each stop. You do not have to go to all of them, pick and choose what works best for you and your travel mates. If you can't get through all of the stops during the day - come back and explore them at a later date!





Time to Depart!

We recommend departing between 9:00 to 9:30 am. The later you leave, the less time you will have to explore all of the stops.

Recommended duration: 45 minutes - 1 hour

Drive time to second stop: 25 minutes

*Light food options are available at this stop

- Best done between Thursday -Sunday. We don't recommend travelling on Monday -Wednesday or holidays.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much will the stops cost?

First Stop: No fee

Second Stop: This stop requires a small parking fee (\$) per person.

Third Stop: No fee

Fourth Stop: No fee

*Please note: gas, tolls, and food may be additional costs.

Should I make a lunch reservation?

We provide a variety of food options on stops #3 and #4. One option on the third stop is a popular winery & cidery spot and totally worth a visit! **We recommend making a reservation ahead of your visit**, especially on weekends (scan QR code to the right here). Otherwise, you can visit one of the other recommended spots without a reservation.

When should we leave?

We recommend leaving between 9:00 and 9:30 am from the London or Sarnia areas. If you are leaving from the Kitchener-Waterloo area we recommend leaving at 8:30 am.

Can I bring my dog?

This trip is **dog-friendly**! Every stop has a few outdoor dog-friendly options; however, note that most of our eat & drink suggestions only allow dogs on outdoor patios. Please keep your dog on a leash at all times.



How long will the total trip take?

See the approximate round-trip driving distances/times below. These are driving distances only and do not factor in time spent at stops.

From Sarnia:

2 hours and 15 minutes / 176 km

From **London**:

2 hours and 30 minutes / 164 km

From Chatham:

3 hours and 20 minutes / 250 km

From Woodstock:

3 hours and 10 minutes / 253 km

From Kitchener*:

4 hours / 325 km

From Windsor*:

5 hours and 20 minutes / 458 km

From Toronto*:

5 hours and 45 minutes / 507 km

*We recommend booking an overnight hotel if the driving distance is greater than 4 hours round-trip.

How many people can I bring with me?

We recommended bringing up to 5 people on your surprise road trip.

If you're bringing a larger group, we highly recommend having one person in charge of booking reservations at restaurants and attractions in advance. Please see the previous page for a copy of the digital itinerary.

Fourth Stop: There are multiple accessible options on this stop.




Risk
